

EIGHTH NOTE FATBACK GROOVES: SNARE DRUM PT.1

Fatback grooves are essentially grooves where the bass drum or snare drum land on the **offbeat 16th notes** within the bar.

We are going to start adding snare drum notes to the 'e' or the 'a' of the beat.
