

SIXTEENTH NOTE COMBINATIONS

The 16 notes in a bar can be divided and played in many combinations. We are going to look at 1, 2 and 3 note combinations and mix them up. You will find these a lot easier if you use a **metronome** to keep you in time. If you are up for an additional challenge, try playing quarter notes with your stepped hi-hat while playing the exercises on your snare.
